\*In conclusion, recite these prayers:

*'I have called you by your name, you are mine...'*  
(Is 43:1)

*'O sing to the Lord a new song, for he has done  
marvelous things.'* (Ps 98:1)

*'I will sing of your steadfast love,  
O Lord, forever.'*

*'Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia,  
O Love, O infinite Love of God.  
Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.'*

*'Our Father...; Hail Mary...; Glory be to the Father...*

*\*And again, spread my word. Hurry, so that for  
these little ones, growing in number every day, help  
may come before it is too late: time is short!*

**THE RITUAL OF BAPTISM FOR  
ABORTED BABIES and STILLBORN BABIES**

**As indicated by the Lord**

“Say this preliminary prayer:

***“The counsel of the Lord stands forever,  
the thoughts of his Heart to all generations.  
[...] to deliver their soul from death, and to  
keep them alive in famine.”*** (Ps 33:11, 19)

\*Recite: ***‘I believe in God...’*** *(The Apostles Creed)*

\*Then take some holy water, and spray it in all directions, saying:

***‘All of you who are stillborn today or will be tonight; all of you who were killed in the womb of your mother; all of you who will be killed: so that, by Jesus Christ, you may have eternal life, I baptize you...***

(here state the names Mary, Joseph, John, etc, and that of the saint of the day for God spreads the holy water on the heads of the children and gives them each a name.) ***...in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.’***



**PRAYER FOR THE SPIRITUAL ADOPTION  
OF AN UNBORN CHILD**

In Order to counter the propaganda for abortion, Msgr. Fulton J. Sheen recommended the spiritual adoption of unborn babies. This was to be done by praying that these little ones be spared abortion, and continue to live after birth. The following prayer, said **every day for one whole year**, was recommended:

**Jesus, Mary, Joseph,  
I love you very much;  
I beg you to spare the life of the unborn  
Child that I have spiritually adopted,  
And which is in danger of being aborted.**

During your earthly life, this child which you have adopted, will be known only to God, but in the hereafter, you will enjoy each other’s company for all eternity.

#### **THE BAPTISM OF UNBORN CHILDREN**

## A MESSAGE FROM JOHN PAUL II

I would like to pass on a special thought to you, *women who have had recourse to abortion*. The Church realizes how you were heavily influenced in your decision, and she has no doubt that, in many cases, this decision was painful and even tragic.

The scar on your soul has probably not yet healed. In fact, what has happened was, and remains, profoundly unjust. But do not let yourselves be discouraged, and do not lose hope.

Rather, try to understand what has happened, and interpret it in truth. If you have not yet done so, open yourself with humility and faith to repentance: the Father of all mercy is waiting for you to offer you his forgiveness and his peace in the sacrament of reconciliation. You will realize that nothing is entirely lost, and you will also be asking for forgiveness from your child, **who is now living in the Lord.**

With the help of counselors and in the presence of competent friends, by means of your painful witnessing, you could be among the most convincing defenders of the right of everyone to life. In your commitment to life, and eventually crowned by the birth of new creatures, in the exercise of welcome and attention towards those who are the most in need of a warm presence, you will work to instill a new way of thinking about human life.

and let them be killed before their birth. I will speak to you more about this tonight.”

Indeed, during that night, the Lord showed me a horrible picture. I saw the earth covered with tiny corpses of babies. It was so horrible that later, I made this note in my journal: “I saw the massacre of The Innocents of Bethlehem, multiplied by thousands and millions.” I cried when I saw this horror.

The Lord then said to me, ‘The impure Spirit has knocked on every door. Most were opened to him. Woe to those who listen to him! On some night, they will sink with their houses into the quagmire of their sins. Standing beside their graves, we lament other children that God has recalled to himself. He is the Master! But we do not grieve over children that were cruelly murdered. On the contrary, the time will come when people will believe that the massacre of these little ones is pleasing to God and men. **Blessed be every house in which resides a soul making reparation.**”

Our narrator continues: “I then saw in the sky a countless number of heads of children. I said, ‘But Lord, these are certainly the heads of your little angels!’ The Lord answered me, ‘Here they are, these little ones whose lives were taken from them. They will be the accusers in front of God’s tribunal. Pray

for their assassins, so that they will repent.” I continued: ‘Lord, why did you show me this? I know that these little ones will never see God’ Jesus then said to me: ‘Mary, you have a great mission to fulfill.

These little ones will be able to go to heaven and see God. Repeat what I’m about to tell you, even to my priests. You will come up against some resistances, but eventually, people will understand, and do it...much to the delight to these little ones. You can baptize them. Finally, to end this narrative, here is a mystical event as experienced by this mother chosen as the messenger. The facts as related by this woman are her personal testimony.

“I myself, gave birth to a stillborn baby of six months. Since the doctor had told me that the baby I was carrying in my womb would not live, I baptized it before he died, on the spot on my belly under which could be found his little head. I prayed to God, saying, ‘My God, let the holy water pass through my belly and spread on the head of the child.’

I felt with certitude that God had granted my wish. About a year later, when I woke up after a serious operation, a beautiful little child was standing beside my bed...I asked him: ‘Who are you, little angel?’”



I then heard: ‘I am your little Werner. Through baptism, you opened heaven to me. I have been praying for you, for your healing. For your happiness and to comfort you, God allowed me to appear to you.

Farewell until we meet again, dear mother!’”

## MERCY

**If you meet a woman who has had an abortion (or more than one) always be merciful! Encourage her to return to God. Speak to her about God's greatest attribute:**

### HIS DIVINE MERCY.

**Jesus said to St. Faustina that the greatest sinners can be the greatest saints if they simply trust in His mercy.**

**Encourage her to beg for God's mercy, go to confession, beg mercy and forgiveness from the child, name the child and allow Jesus the wounded healer to gently and patiently heal her wounds. Jesus said, "Come to me all...."**
