

Mary is the Mediatrix of all grace. She gave birth to Jesus, Author of all grace (cf. Lk. 2:7), and “ by her manifold intercession” distributes to us “the gifts of eternal salvation” (Second Vatican Council, Lumen Gentium, 62). Mary is our Advocate, who intercedes on our behalf to Jesus, as she did at the wedding of Cana (cf. Jn. 2:1-10, Lumen Gentium, 62).

The apparitions and messages of the Lady of All Nations in Amsterdam (1945-1959) were ecclesiastically approved as being of supernatural origin by the competent Church authority, Bishop Josef M. Punt, Bishop of Haarlem/Amsterdam (May 31, 2002). The messages of Our Lady of All Nations call for the papal proclamation of Mary Co-redemptrix, Mediatrix, Advocate, in what will be the “last and greatest” Marian dogma (August 15, 1951 message).

On February 11, 1951, Our Lady gave the following prayer that would precede and prepare the way for the dogma of Mary Co-redemptrix, Mediatrix, Advocate:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Father, send now Your Spirit over the earth. Let the Holy Spirit live in the hearts of all nations, that they may be preserved from degeneration, disaster, and war. May the Lady of all nations, who once was Mary, be our Advocate. Amen.

The crucial need for unity in the Holy Spirit between all nations and the prevention of “degeneration, disaster, and war” through the advocacy of Our Lady, as prayed for in the Prayer of the Lady of All Nations, seems to be a growing imperative for today’s world which is under growing threat of war, terrorism, famine, and moral crisis. As explained by Bishop Punt in his Declaration of May 31, 2002: “Unlike Holy Scripture, private revelations are never binding upon the conscience of the faithful. They are a help in understanding the signs of the times and to help live more fully the Gospel (cf. Lk. 12:56, Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 67). And the signs of our times are dramatic. The devotion of the Lady of All Nations can help us, in my sincere conviction, in guiding us on the right path during the present serious drama of our times, the path to a new and special outpouring of the Holy Spirit, who alone can heal the great wounds of our times” (In Response to Inquiries Concerning the Lady of All Nations Apparitions, May 31, 2002).

We invite you to participate in a worldwide and continuous daily novena to the Lady of All Nations for the Papal Proclamation of the Dogma of Mary Co-redemptrix, Mediatrix, Advocate, that the Holy Spirit may descend anew with the precious gift of peace for our world in crisis. Please pray the prayer of the Lady of All Nations nine times daily, for the intention of the proclamation of the Dogma of Mary Co-redemptrix, Mediatrix, Advocate and for true world peace. The prayers may be prayed consecutively at one time or throughout the day.

“All generations will call me blessed” (Lk 1:48).

The Church has historically declared the Mother of Jesus “blessed” in the form of four solemnly defined truths or dogmas. In 431, the Council of Ephesus declared her the “Mother of God” as the true human mother of the Word made Flesh. In 649, Pope Martin I at the Lateran Council declared her the “Perpetual Virgin” who was virginal before, during, and after the birth of Christ. In 1854, Bl. Pius IX solemnly defined the “Immaculate Conception” of Mary, who was conceived without original sin through the merits of Jesus Christ. In 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the “Assumption” of Mary, who at the end of her earthly life was taken up to heaven, body and soul.

The Church teaches a fifth doctrine regarding the Virgin Mary that has not yet been solemnly defined: her mission as Spiritual Mother of all nations and peoples, and its three roles as Co-redemptrix, Mediatrix, and Advocate. Mary is invoked in the Church as the Co-redemptrix, for her unique human participation with and under Jesus, her divine Son, in the Redemption of the world. Pope John Paul II has referred to the Blessed Virgin as the Co-redemptrix on numerous occasions, due to her “yes” that gave the Redeemer his body, the instrument of Redemption (cf. Lk. 1:38, Heb. 10:10), and for suffering with him unto Calvary for the Redemption of the human family (cf. Jn. 19:26-27).
