## O Shepherd (December 16th)

O SHEPHERD that rules Israel, Thou that leads Joseph like a sheep:

Come to guide and comfort us.

O God With Us (December 23rd) O Emmanuel




O EMMANUEL, Our King and our Law-giver, Longing of the Gentiles, yea, and salvation thereof, **Come** to save us, O Lord our God!

A novena is a prayer for nine days, prayed as preparation for some particular feast or in order to obtain some special favor. The model and the first of all novenas was that made in the Cenacle after the Ascension of Our Lord, by the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin in preparation for the coming of the Holy Ghost.

The earliest recorded ecclesiastical novena, is the Christmas Novena, which commemorates the nine months during which the Christ-child was carried in the womb of His Mother.

Each of the seven *O Antiphons* address Jesus with a title, which comes from the prophecies of *Isaiah* that anticipate *the coming of the Messiah*. The first letters of the titles in the original Latin in reverse order spell "Ero Cras," meaning . . .The Seven O Antiphons
