FIRST MONDAY

THIRD MONDAY

Pray the same prayer you prayed on the First Monday. Then make your petition and say three times: "Saint Nicholas, come for my petition;". Then conclude with the final Praise and Prayer

PRAISE

Full of sweet hope today I come to you, my saint, as I trust in your goodness in finding my happiness.


I know well that my confidence will not be let down, and that I will see my fervent petition answered, as you will calm the affliction of this anguished soul.
