*This novena prayer, although short is sufficient. It would be better of course to add, if time permits, **three** Hail Mary's **or** say **five times** The Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be to the Father, or to use some of the many well-loved novena prayers from other sources. Remember that prayers must be said with the lips in order to gain the indulgences. This novena starts on January 18 and ends on January 25.*

O Lord Jesus Christ, who said unto Your Apostles, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you," regard not our sins, but the faith of Your church, and grant unto her that peace and unity which are agreeable to Your will, who live and reign, God, forever and ever. Amen.


O Lord, increase in us the faith.

Prayed from: January 18 and ends on January 25



NOVENA FOR CHURCH UNITY-SHORT FORM

The word Novena derives its name from the Latin word “novem” meaning “nine.” A novena can be either a private or public devotion in the Catholic Church to obtain special graces.

(For 9 Consecutive Days beginning on January 18 and ending on January 25, say the following prayers...)

O Lord Jesus Christ,
who said unto Your Apostles,
"Peace I leave with you,
My peace I give unto you,"
regard not our sins,
but the faith of Your church,
and grant unto her that peace and unity which
are agreeable to Your will,
who live and reign,
God, forever and ever.

Amen.

O Lord, increase in us the faith.

Five Our Father...

Our Father, who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come;
thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread;
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
