- V. We have sinned, in not improving ourselves, by the talents of grace and nature, which Thy bounty has committed to us; and by idly spending that precious time, and unthankfully neglecting those gracious means, which Thy goodness has allowed us for the work of our salvation; R. Have mercy on us.
- V. Have mercy on us, most Merciful Father, and pardon the multitude of our offenses; remember what our substance is; that we are but as the grass of the field, or as vapor that passes away, and returns no more; remember what Thou art; infinitely glorious in Thyself, and infinitely good to the least of Thy creatures; remember the gracious promises of Jesus Christ; and for the merits of His Sacred Passion,
