# **RITE OF EUCHARISTIC EXPOSITION AND BENEDICTION**

The service of benediction consists of suitable readings, songs and prayer. Hymns appropriate for this service are given below.

## **ADORATION**

During the exposition there should be prayers, songs and readings to direct the attention of the faithful to the worship of the Eucharistic Lord Jesus. There should be readings from Scripture with a homily to develop a better understanding of the Eucharistic mystery.
