Who Are You Killing?

She was the third child, and her father did not make very much money. Her mother was advised to have an abortion by her doctor. He told her they could have another child when circumstances were better. Her mother, who was a new Catholic convert, became frightened, and went to her priest for advice.

He told her to have faith, and to give the child to the Blessed Mother. He said that Our Lady, *Our* Mother, would see to it that the child and the family would be provided for. He said that Our Lady obtains everything She asks for from God, and that there is no better intercessor to implore, especially regarding motherhood. The woman listened, and the baby was born.

The child was named Loretta, and she was a most beautiful and healthy child. She was so charming, that by the time she was four years of age, she was already making money for the family... and she supported her family and her mother, until the latter died at the age of 96!

Her full name was Loretta Young, and she said to those contemplating an abortion. "Be careful; be very careful. Abortion is wrong to start with, but in addition, you do not know who or what you are aborting. Among them might be a Joan of Arc, a Mother Teresa, or even a Pope." And, we might add... or even a Loretta Young.

Later in her life, Loretta made two pilgrimages to Medjugorje. In 1986, within one week after listening to the audio tape "Beyond the Fields," she was on her way to Medjugorje with her second son, Peter, and a friend who did some work for her, for a five-day visit. She felt that the experience was wonderful.

On her second pilgrimage in 1994, she was accompanied by her husband, Jean Louis. He was 86, and she was 81. Of her pilgrimages, she said, "I have visited several shrines, but no place has affected me quite as much as Medjugorje. It keeps growing within after one returns home. I think that is because the Blessed Mother is still appearing there. I don't just believe that: I know it is true."

In Medjugorje, her husband's Rosary turned from silver to gold. After he died, that Rosary was of particular comfort to her. She said, "My fifteen decades each day sustain me in the belief that this tiny miracle was Our Blessed Mother's way of assuring me that Jean would be well taken care of. Medjugorje was, for me, both times, an incredible experience. I think that it has changed my entire life."

On August 12, 2000, the charming actress Loretta Young, went to her heavenly reward. She was 87. She was one of the greatest actresses of all time. For a half-century, she charmed movie and TV audiences with her beauty and wholesome image. She became one of the first actresses to win both a movie Oscar award, and a TV Emmy. She made nearly 100 films opposite top actors, and she had her own program on TV for nine years.

Her award-winning: *The Loretta Young Show,"* in the 1950's was unique, in that each story taught a lesson that would help people to live a better life. Anyone who saw them will remember her floating through the door, swirling her very feminine skirt right into the living room. (She would spin around, because she knew that women wanted to see the back of her lovely dress, as well as the front.) Inspiringly, each program ended with a Bible quote.
